

Electric Pallet Jack

There is a lever that steers the unit and raises the jack by acting as a pump handle when required. A small handle located on the tiller allows the forks to be lowered to the ground. Hydraulic fluid is discharged when the handle is activated. The front wheels are found inside the fork ends mounted on levers. The levers are attached to specific linkages that have their own levers uniting with a cylinder. This system enables the links to force the wheels down once the hydraulic jack is raised at the end. Raised vertically above the front wheels, the forks only travel high enough to clear the floor to maintain safety. Typically, pallet jacks have steering wheels located in the front and each fork often comes with a single or double wheel configuration.
